Oceanside Students Take A Look At Teaching

Grant from NYS Teachers Union Will Fund Mentoring Opportunities

In late October, 80 high school and middle school students who had signed up for the district's new Take A Look At Teaching (TALAT) club met in the OHS library for the TALAT kickoff. The event featured New York State teacher of the year, Billy Green, as the special guest and speaker.

The TALAT club offers students who are interested in careers in education the opportunity to learn about the profession and the pathways to becoming certified. They will also have many mentors within their own schools and at Long Island University, which is partnering with the district.

Jennifer Wolfe, an Oceanside High School teacher who was the 2021-22 New York State teacher of the year, led the kick-off event with Kathy Smith, a middle school English teacher,

and Helen Dixon, who teaches the College Elementary Education elective at OHS which offers college credit to students. Ms. Smith and Ms. Dixon will serve as advisors to their schools' TALAT club chapters.

The TALAT initiative is funded by a \$10,000 grant from the New York State Teachers Union,

aimed at forestalling a looming teacher shortage. Student enrollment is projected to grow across the state in the years ahead and many veteran teachers are nearing retirement age.

Gavin Kalner, a social studies teacher at Oceanside High School, wrote the grant proposal with support from Betsy Weinman, the district's professional development center coordinator. Already many Oceanside teachers have agreed to work with the TALAT students.

Merit Scholars Announced

Lyndsay Chetkof and Charles Wang of Oceanside High School have been named National Merit Scholarship Competition (NMSC) Semifinalists. Students are entered into the competition when they take the pre-SAT exam and are selected on the basis of their high scores.

Semifinalists represent less than one percent of all U.S. high school seniors. In addition to the prestige that being a semifinalist adds to their college resumes, Lyndsay and Charles now have the opportunity to continue in the



competition with the potential to win scholarship awards.

Liora Raimondi, Janine Chi and Victor Gomez were named Commended Scholars. They represent the top 3 percent of students taking the exam nationwide. Commended Scholars do not continue in the NMSC but may become candidates for special scholarships sponsored by businesses.

OMS Welcomes Author Megan Freeman

Students and teachers at Oceanside Middle School have been reading aloud together to finish the book *Alone* in time for author Megan Freeman's visit. The book is about a young girl who wakes up in her Colorado town to find that everyone is mysteriously gone. How she learns to survive with only a dog as her companion is the focus of the story.

Ms. Freeman spoke with groups of students and signed copies of her book, which is written in verse like an epic poem. Ms. Freeman is an award-winning novelist, poet and former teacher.

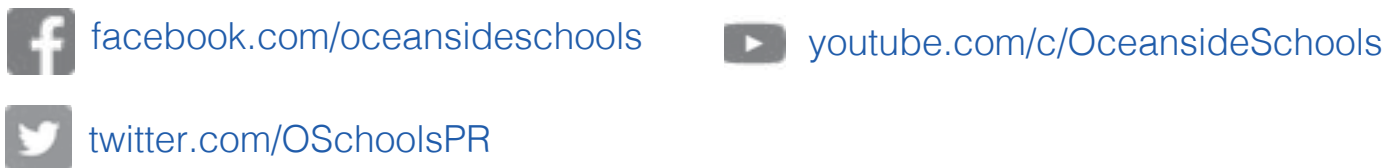
